► Eligibility requirements

- For admission into the two-year Master's programme at Chimie ParisTech, ENSAE ParisTech, ENSTA ParisTech, Institut d'Optique Graduate School, MINES ParisTech or Telecom ParisTech, you are required to have successfully completed at least 3 years of a Bachelor's degree in Science or Engineering at your home university by September 2009.
- For admission into the three-year Master's programme at Ecole Polytechnique, you are required to have successfully completed 4 to 6 semesters of a Bachelor's degree in Science or Engineering at your home university by January 2010.

- Students studying at Novosibirsk should contact Mrs. Michele Debrenne. Students studying at Tomsk, Moscow or St. Petersburg should contact the International Office of their university to participate in the pre-selection procedure.

- Students wishing to apply to Ecole Polytechnique AND other ParisTech schools MUST complete the ParisTech on-line application AND the Ecole Polytechnique on-line application on www.polytechnique.edu
- Applications to the Ecole Polytechnique site must be received no later than 1st October 2009; Application to the ParisTech site no later than 5th October 2009. Late applications will not be considered.
- Eligible applicants will be asked to take a written test in October 2009 and will be interviewed in Russia between the end of October and the beginning of December 2009 by ParisTech representatives (see website for more details)
- Final admission results will be announced by mid-December 2009.

► Scholarships

Admitted students will benefit from a tuition waiver (up to €18,000 a year) for the total duration of their stay at their host Graduate School. Scholarships (of up to €15,000 a year) covering travel and living expenses in France may be awarded to outstanding applicants by the French authorities or by industrial sponsors.
