Key Speakers

Vera A. Dugartsyrenova is an Associate Professor at the Faculty of World Economy and International Affairs of the National Research University Higher School of Economics, Moscow. Her research interests include academic writing, blended and distance language learning, CMC tools for language and intercultural learning, and learners' perceptions of technology use in the foreign language classroom. She has an extensive experience designing online professional development courses on instructional technology use in language teaching and learning, and has taught EAP (English for Academic Purposes) and ESP (English for Specific Purposes) courses to students majoring in economics, political science, mathematics, linguistics, intercultural communication, and psychology.

Peter A. Stepichev, PhD is NATE executive director, MELTA vice-president, teacher trainer and author. His patented tool "Grammar Cube" (ГрамИК) and a series of board games won the recognition in 2012 Moscow Teacher of the Year contest, resulting in winning a scholarship to study at Norwich (England) and Germany. This experience as well as participation in 2014 IPV program in the USA allows the presenter to share lots of practical ideas for the lesson for teachers hungry for new approaches and unconventional teaching practices.

Olga M. Kochenkova is a teacher trainer, ELT consultant for Pearson ELT in Novosibirsk. She found her true passion in life as an English teacher back in 1991. Olga has shared her ideas with teachers and educators all over Russia and at some international ELT Conferences. Olga is certified with TKT, CAE and CPE and currently helps teachers excel at those exams. Olga worked for 21 years at Novosibirsk Municipal Pedagogical Lyceum, has Higher Qualifications as a school teacher and gained several significant awards in the sphere.

Olga Yu. Chekchurina is the deputy director of interregional **INJAZ group** which is dealing in teacher development workshops, seminars and trainings all over Russian Federation. From 1998 to 2003 Olga has been appointed invigilator of ESOL Pitman Exams. Together with Ms Daria Mastyugina, the Oxford University Press representative and manager has developed and implemented tests and syllabi for secondary schools in Novosibirsk taking part in "Oxford Quality Programme" which was part of global applied linguistics and ELT methodology project in the Russian Federation from 2007 to 2010. Olga has been working as a teacher at different language schools in Novosibirsk, and as invited lecturer for the State Teacher Training University of Novosibirsk (Foreign Language Department) and SIMOR (Siberian Institute of International Relations and Regional Studies). Olga's special interests as a teacher are Debates in English, Literature Speaking Clubs and specially tailored methodology courses.
