- Location: University of Regensburg

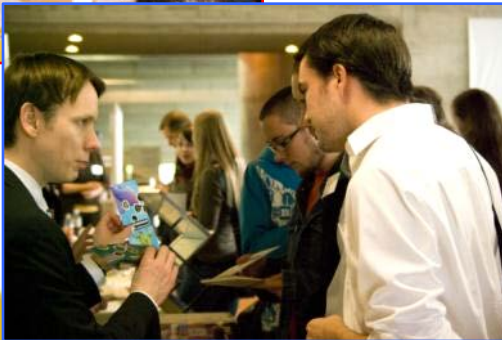
Targets

- 7 state-owned art academies

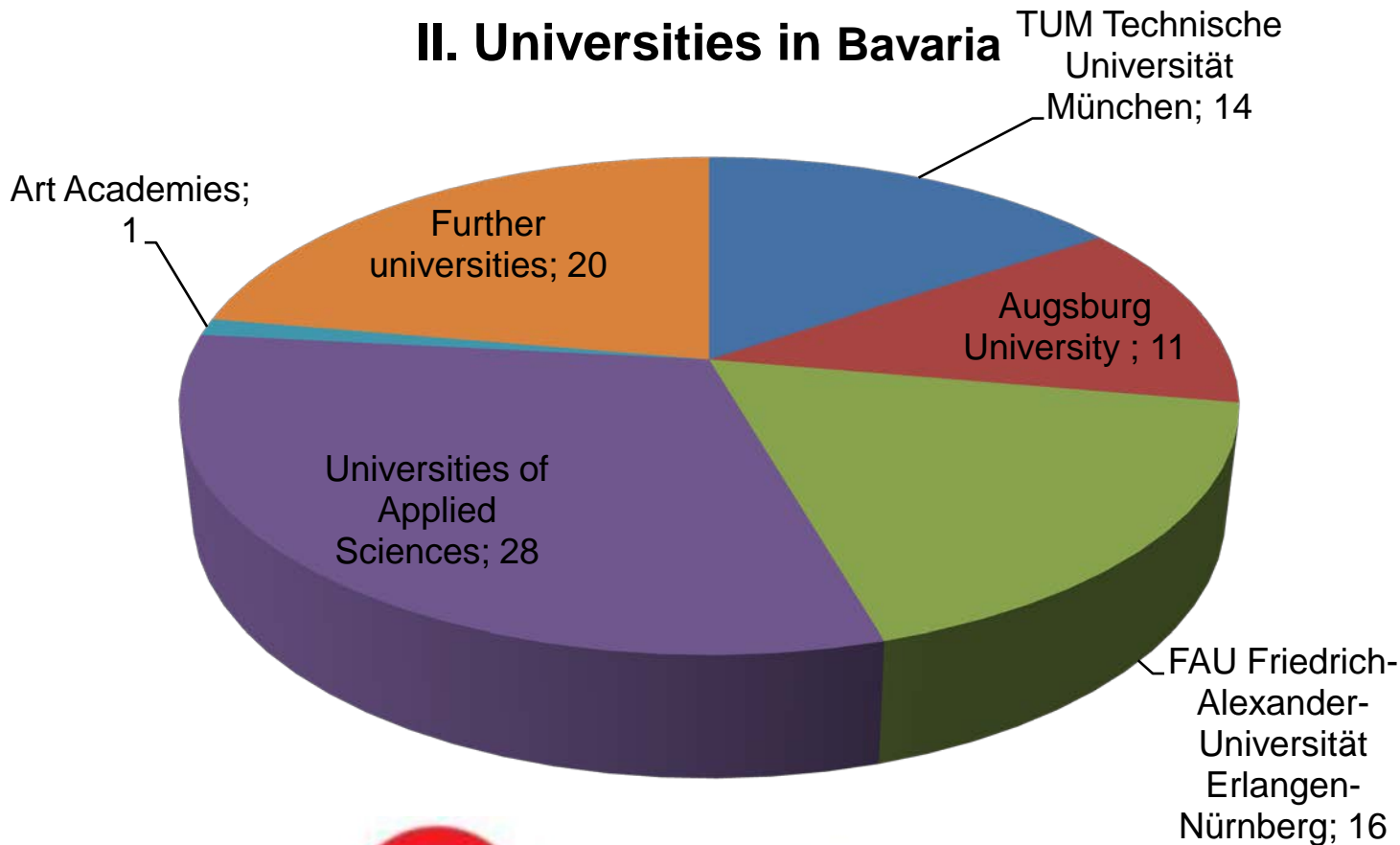

- Establishing of contacts with Bavarian institutions of higher education with a corresponding scientific profile with whom you can organize exchange of students and scientists, common research projects, summer schools and study programs
- Advice on study programs in Bavaria for your graduates



Establishing cooperation between Russian and Bavarian universities

What we need from you:

- Specific proposals for cooperation and detailed information on study programs and research at your university
- Being open for starting with small steps (bottom-up approach), even without an agreement
- Support by the university management **and** by scientists

How to increase the number of students from Germany going to Russia?

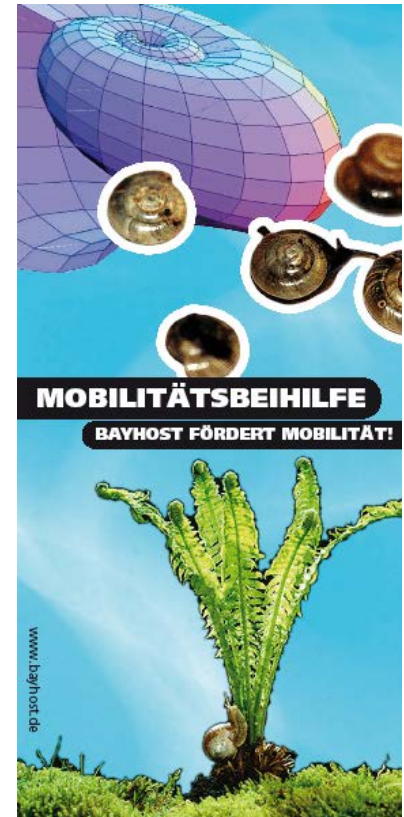
Present situation:

The number of German students who want to go to Russia is relatively small – but those ones are **really** interested!

There is a considerable number of German students having a Russian background and the desire to rediscover the **country** of their parents.

Suggestions for attracting German students to Russia

- Creating more partnerships with German universities
- Enhancing individual mobility outside university cooperation:
 - ➔ summer courses and offers in English language on affordable conditions
- Preparatory courses in Germany on Russian language and culture



Suggestions for attracting German students to Russia

- Better access to information: user-friendly university websites including information in English
- Availability of contact persons in the international offices - avoiding the „no-answer-phenomenon“ 😊
- Internship services: practical experience in companies, state institutions, social and cultural organizations etc.
