### **Abstract**

Abstract within 1-2 pages should state the aim, methods and results to allow a scientific assessment of the proposed presentation. Please make sure that your abstract is written in grammatically correct English and free of all spelling and typing errors. The name of the presenting author should be underlined as shown above.

All abstracts will be reviewed by the Organizing Committee, and you will be notified whether your abstract has been accepted for a presentation.

There are no very strict rules for the abstract format. However, you may follow the following guidelines when preparing your abstract.

#### **Text:**

Size: 12 pt

Font: Times New Roman

Note: 3 blanks in front of each paragraph

#### **Equations:**

Processing software: MS-Word embedded Equation Editor

Size: 12 pt

Font: Times New Roman

Alignment: Center

#### **Equation and Reference numbers:**

Size: 12 pt

Font: Times New Roman

Note: a number in a pair of round brackets for equation numbers, i.e. (1); and a number in a pair of square brackets for Reference numbers, i.e. [1].

Alignment: Right

#### **Figures:**

Size: No specific requirement

Lines and photos: readable and distinguishable

Captions: 10 pt – 12 pt (readable) with Font of ‘Times New Roman’
