

MENTE ARGENTINA SCHOLARSHIPS

Mente recognizes that for many students, scholarships are a important and even a necessity in order to study abroad. Keeping this in mind, year after year, Mente Argentina has offered various scholarships for our programs in Buenos Aires. The Mente Argentina Scholarship Program is designed for motivated students who plan to study abroad, however, feel that they need assistance to cover the costs of travel and the program fees.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** For full eligibility requirements, click here.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded \$500 to \$2,500 USD for programs lasting between 1 semester and 1 academic year.
- **DEADLINE:** The completed materials for this scholarship and application must be sent and received at least 120 days before the program start date. Learn more here.

THE ROBERTO ROCCA EDUCATION PROGRAM

The Roberto Rocca Education Program awards scholarships to students attending 16 universities throughout Argentina.

BOREN SCHOLARSHIPS

Boren Scholarships, an initiative of the National Security Education Program, provide unique funding opportunities for U.S. undergraduate students to study less commonly taught languages in world regions critical to U.S. interests, and underrepresented in study abroad. The countries of Western Europe, Canada, Australia, and New Zealand are excluded.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** These scholarships are open to U.S. citizens planning an overseas program in selected countries. For full eligibility requirements, click here.

SPANISH STUDIES ABROAD SCHOLARSHIPS

Spanish Studies Abroad has awarded over \$230,000 USD in scholarships since 2001. They offer two scholarship options for students attending their regular academic programs in Spain, Puerto Rico, Cuba and Argentina. You may submit an application to only one scholarship: Merit-Based or Diversity.

UNIVERSIDAD AUSTRAL SCHOLARSHIPS

The vision of Universidad Austral includes both supporting all students with talent and enthusiasm to study undergraduate careers, so that no one who wishes to be deprived of doing so due to economic difficulties, as well as rewarding those who have demonstrated an high academic commitment during high school.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** These scholarships are open to those applicants with a secondary education grade equal to or above 9. Eligibility varies depending on the scholarship. For full eligibility requirements, click here.

UNIVERSIDAD DE BELGRANO



MELBOURNE INTERNATIONAL UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

The International Undergraduate Scholarships were established by the University of Melbourne in recognition of the significant contribution made by international students to the diversity of the university's student population.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to citizens of countries other than Australia and New Zealand and are not a permanent resident of Australia; Applicants must have received an unconditional offer for an undergraduate course and must have achieved excellent final year school results.
- **AWARD:** The University awards around 30 scholarships with a \$10,000 tuition fee remission in the first year of an undergraduate degree and around 10 scholarships with a 100% tuition fee remission for the normal full-time duration of an undergraduate degree. Students who have accepted a \$10,000 fee remission scholarship will also be considered for a 100% fee remission scholarship.
- **DEADLINE:** No application is required. You will be automatically considered for this award. Learn more here.

ADELAIDE SCHOLARSHIPS INTERNATIONAL (ASI)

The University of Adelaide offers Adelaide Scholarships International (ASI) to attract high quality overseas postgraduate students to areas of research strength in the University of Adelaide to support its research efforts.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to international (excluding Australian/New Zealand citizens and Australian Permanent Residents) students who have successfully completed at least the equivalent of an Australian First Class Honors degree. Generally applicants who succeed in winning an ASI scholarship have completed a master's degree including a significant research component and have several publications and relevant work and research experience.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded course tuition fees for two years for a master's degree by research and three years for a doctoral research degree (an extension is possible for doctoral programs only); an annual living allowance (\$28,092 in 2020) for two years for a master's degree by research and three years for a doctoral research degree (an extension is possible for doctoral programs only). - **DEADLINE:** 10 July 2020 for Semester 1, 2021. Learn more here.

AUSTRALIA AWARDS SCHOLARSHIPS

Australia Awards Scholarships are long term development awards administered by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade. They aim to contribute to the long term development needs of Australia's partner countries in line with bilateral and regional agreements.

- ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship is open to international students from Asia, Pacific, Africa and Middle East. For full eligibility requirements, click here.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded tuition fees, travel allowance, contribution to living expenses, text books and study materials.
- **DEADLINE:** 30 June 2020 depending on the country of the applicant. Learn more here.

FLINDERS UNIVERSITY: AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT RESEARCH TRAINING PROGRAM (AGRTP) SCHOLARSHIP (INTERNATIONAL)

The Australian Government Research Training Program (AGRTP) Scholarships (International) are specifically intended to support international students to undertake a research higher degree at Flinders University.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** For full eligibility requirements, click here.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded tuition fees charged by Flinders University for a research higher degree, as well as a living allowance paid at the rate of \$28,092 (2020 rate).

MACQUARIE VICE-CHANCELLOR'S INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Macquarie University Vice-Chancellor's International Scholarship provides a partial tuition fee scholarship for outstanding students to study at Macquarie University North Ryde campus.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** For full eligibility requirements, click **here**.
- **AWARD:** Recipients will be awarded up to \$10,000 AUD and it will be applied towards their tuition fee.
- **DEADLINE:** The deadline varies depending on the scholarship. Learn more here.

LA TROBE COLLEGE EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS

The La Trobe College Excellence Scholarship (CES) is a scholarship available to international students to cover tuition fees for high-achieving international students accepted into their undergraduate and postgraduate coursework programs.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to citizens of a country other than Australia or New Zealand who are applying to start an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework program in 2020.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded between 15%, 20% and 25% deduction on annual tuition fees for the duration of their studies and are limited in number.
- **DEADLINE:** The deadline varies depending on the scholarship. Learn more **here**.

MONASH INTERNATIONAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

The Monash University Scholarship program offers over 200 scholarships for new and current students.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to students who meet the following requirements: Applicants must be an international student; commencing a full-time undergraduate or postgraduate (coursework) degree at a Monash campus in Australia (you must have received a full Monash course offer); must not be the recipient of any other scholarships, grants or financial incentives funded by Monash University or be sponsored by other bodies/institutions. - **AWARD:** Recipients will be awarded 100% course fees paid until the minimum number of points for their degree are completed (excludes OSHC, accommodation and living costs).
- **DEADLINE:** This scholarship has a rolling deadline. Learn more here.

AUSTRALIA RESEARCH TRAINING PROGRAM (RTP) SCHOLARSHIPS

The RTP provides block grants, on a calendar year basis, to higher education providers (HEPs) to support both domestic and overseas students undertaking research doctorate and research master's degrees, known as higher degrees by research (HDRs).

- ELIGIBILITY: This scholarship is open to domestic or overseas students enrolled in an accredited HDR course of study at an Australian HEP. Applications for RTP Scholarships need to be made directly to participating universities. Each university has its own application and selection process, please contact your chosen university.
- **AWARD:** Recipients will be awarded up to \$43,110 AUD depending on the program and financial need.
- **DEADLINE:** The deadline varies per university but is around April-October each year. During COVID-19 pandemic, it is possible to extend the scholarschip duration. Learn more here.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ACADEMIC MERIT SCHOLARSHIP (GRIFFITH UNIVERSITY)

International Student Academic Merit Scholarship rewards high achieving international students applying for undergraduate and postgraduate coursework programs at Griffith University.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** You have to be a citizen of a country other than Australia or New Zealand, have a minimum GPA in previous studies of 5.0 to 5.49 on a 7 point scale or equivalent, satisfy all academic and English language entry requirements for your chosen undergraduate or postgraduate coursework program, and be a full-time student starting in either Trimester 3 2020, or Trimester 1, 2 or 3 2021.
- **AWARD:** 20% of tuition fees for the entire degree.
- **DEADLINE:** Simply apply to study a program at Griffith University and they will evaluate if you are eligible. Learn more here.

UNIVERSITY OF SYDNEY INTERNATIONAL STRATEGIC SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is funded by the University of Sydney and provides tuition fees offset and stipend to high quality international postgraduate students who wish to enrol in or are currently enrolled in a research degree here.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** The receipient must be be a commencing or enrolled international student who has an outstanding record of academic achievement and research potential and have an unconditional offer of admission or be currently enrolled in a master's by research or PhD at the University of Sydney.
- AWARD: For 2020 awards, the scholarship is valued at \$35,000 per annum. The scholarship assists with OSHC, tuition fees and living costs.
- **DEADLINE:** Applications are open all year round.

HUMBER INTERNATINAL ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

This entrance scholarship is available for Graduate Certificate, Diploma, and Advanced Diploma students joining Humber in January 2021.

- ELIGIBILITY: Students with a high academic qualification (students with GPA 85%+ and 6.5+ IELTS (or equivalent in TOEFL, Duolingo, senior high school grade in English)) looking to be rewarded for their performance in the senior year of high school, college or university. A total of 10 undergraduate and 10 graduate eligible new international students will be awarded a CAD 2,000 scholarship. Scholarships will be awarded on the first come, first served basis for students that received their Letter of Acceptance and confirmed their offer before September 15th 2020. Eligible students must pay their tuition fees in full and scholarship amount will be credited to the student account after the 10th day of classes. The scholarship will be disbursed in two installments over the 1st two semesters.
- **AWARD:** CAD 2,000 off student's tuition fees over the course of thefirst year of studies.
- **DEADLINE:** This scholarship has a rolling deadline as it is offered more than once. Learn more here.

YORK UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

York University in Ontario, Canada offers several International Entrance Scholarships to international students for full time undergraduate study.

UNIVERSITY OF BRITISH COLUMBIA INTERNATIONAL MAJOR **ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS (IMES)**

IMES is a merit based scholarship for students who are offered admission at the University of British Columbia. Students must be on a study permit and demonstrate outstanding academic achievement.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** As soon as you receive an offer of admission to UBC, you'll automatically be considered for these merit-based awards. Consideration is based on your demonstrated academic achievement and your extracurricular involvement. Learn more here.
- **AWARD:** The award varies depending on the scholarship.

UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA GRADUATE FELLOWHIPS

The Government of Manitoba has provided funds to ensure that Manitoba's best students continue education at home, to foster research that leads to economic growth and to attract excellent students to study in Manitoba.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to students with a minimum GPA of 3.75 (above B+) in each of the last two years of study at a recognized university based on a bachelor's, master's graduate diploma or a doctoral degree. For full eligibility requirements, click here.
- AWARD: PhD winners are awarded \$18,000 CAD per year while master's winners are awarded \$14,000 CAD per year.

CHINA SCHOLARSHIP COUNCIL (UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA)

Established in 2014, the "China Scholarship Council – University of Manitoba Joint Funding Program" is a collaborative program of the University of Manitoba and the China Scholarship Council that funds study at UM for PhD students from China.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** Before applying, candidates must meet the minimum Ph.D. admission requirements as set by the University of Manitoba and obtain an unconditional admission letter from the Faculty of Graduate Studies. For full eligibility requirements, click here.
- AWARD: The university will provide support towards the tuition fee and international differential fee for up to 48 months under the condition that the scholarships from the China Scholarship Council (CSC) have been secured. The CSC will provide scholarship support covering visa application fees, one roundtrip airfare between China and Winnipeg by the most economical rout, food and accommodation, and health insurance expenses.
- **DEADLINE:** 5 April 2021.

UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA SCHOLARSHIPS

The University of Alberta offers many scholarship opportunities to undergraduate and graduate students with outstanding academic potential. They offer more than \$28 million CAD in undergraduate scholarships and financial support each year, and our graduate funding rates rank among the highest in Canada.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** Students will be considered automatically for several scholarships when they are admitted to the University of Alberta. Learn more here.

MCGILL UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL STUDENT FUNDING

McGill recognizes the challenges International students can face when studying away from home. The Scholarships and Student Aid Office is committed to ensuring that qualified students from any geographic region are financially supported in their goals to enter and complete academic programs at the University. - **ELIGIBILITY:** These scholarships are open to undergraduate and graduate students of all nationalities who are accepted to McGill University.

PIERRE ELLIOTT TRUDEAU FOUNDATION

This three-year leadership program is designed to train Engaged Leaders, equipping outstanding doctoral candidates with the skills to translate their ideas into action, for the betterment of their communities, Canada, and the world. Up to 16 doctoral Scholars are selected each year and receive generous funding for their studies in addition to leadership training in the context of Brave Spaces.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** For full eligibility requirements, click here.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded \$40,000 CAD per year for three years and \$20,000 CAD per year for three years for research and travel allowance. Learn more here.
- **DEADLINE:** 5 January 2021.

WATERLOO INTERNATIONAL MASTER'S AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

The University of Waterloo is offering the International Master's Award of Excellence (IMAE) to international students who wish to undertake Master's degree programs that are research-based.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must be International students with a valid Canadian study permit who are registered full time and assessed international tuition fees. The scholarship will normally be awarded to Master's degree students in research-based programs (thesis or major research paper). Only students entering the first term of their program are eligible.
- **AWARD:** The scholarship award is valued at \$2,500 CAD per term for a maximum of 5 terms.
- **DEADLINE:** Students will be automatically considered for this award based on their application for admission; hence no separate scholarship application is required. The application deadline for most Master's programs commencing September 2021 fall within January to February 2021. See the official website (link) for the application deadlines specific to each Master's degree program.

VARNIER CANADA GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

This scholarship, launched by the government of Canada, is designed to help well qualified doctoral students pursue their studies in renowned Canadian institutions.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to Canadian citizens, permanent citizens of Canda and foreign citizens. Applicants will be considered on three equally weighted selection criteria: academic excellence, research potential and leadership.
- **AWARD:** Recipients will be awarded \$50,000 CAD per year for three years during doctoral studies.
- **DEADLINE:** Consult nominating institution for submission deadline. Learn more here.

INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL FOR CANADIAN STUDIES: GRADUATE STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The ICCS offers 6 scholarships annually to young international scholars to spend 4-6 weeks at a Canadian University for research in the field of Canadian studies.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** These scholarships are open to students in the social sciences or humanities field who are preparing for a graduate thesis or dissertation on Canada.
- **AWARD:** Recipients will be awarded up to \$4,000 CAD for all expenses.
- **DEADLINE:** November I earn more here

CANADA-CHINA SCHOLARS' EXCHANGE PROGRAM (CCSEP)

Established in 1973, the CCSEP was the result of an undertaking by then Chinese premier Zhou Enlai and Canadian Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau. The CCSEP is an official exchange program between the two countries designed to enhance Chinese scholars' and professionals' knowledge and understanding of Canada. Scholarships are usually for four to 12 month periods of research in Canada, but do not involve formal enrolment at a Canadian university. The recipients are placed as visiting scholars.

- ELIGIBILITY: Canada offers awards to full-time, permanent teaching or research staff, master's or doctoral graduates as well as non-academics in China holding senior professional posts (e.g., judges, broadcasters, economists) so that upon their return home they can make a distinctive contribution to life in China and to mutual understanding between Canada and China.
- AWARD: The China Scholarship Council provides a round-trip international travel fee and visa application fee. The Canadian side provides scholarship living expenses (\$2,200 CAD per month) and medical insurance expenses during the study in Canada.
- **DEADLINE:** Could be delayed due to COVID-19. Learn more here.

WINNIPEG PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIPS FOR WORLD LEADERS

The University of Winnipeg President's Scholarship for World Leaders is awarded to international students entering any of the University's divisions for the first time. Applicants must have a minimum 80% admission average or equivalent and must be involved in activities that demonstrate leadership.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** Candidates must have a minimum 80% admission average or equivalent. They need to be an international student who is entering the first year of any program. Candidates have to demonstrate exceptional leadership qualities.
- **AWARD:** \$5,000 CAD. **DEADLINE:** 1 June 2021.

ENTRANCE AWARDS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS (CARLETON UNIVERSITY)

Carleton University awards scholarships tenable at the University, in the Fall/Winter session of the year of offer to entrance and in-course full-time undergraduate students who have demonstrated a high potential for university studies. The intention of the scholarship policy is to recognize, attract and provide incentives for excellence.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** Students will be considered automatically for several scholarships when they are admitted to the Carleton University. It can vary depending on the scholarship.
- **AWARD:** The award varies depending on the scholarship.
- **DEADLINE:** The deadline varies depending on the scholarship. Learn more **here**.

UNIVERSITY OF CALGARY INTERNATIONAL ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

The University of Calgary International Entrance Scholarship is a prestigious award that recognizes outstanding accomplishments of an international student beginning their undergraduate studies at the University in the Fall term. The criteria for the Scholarship includes not only academic excellence but also accomplishments outside the classroom.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** Applicants must be international students who are registered full-time in an undergraduate degree program that commences in the Fall term. They have to be new students. To be considered for a scholarship, a student must normally present a minimum GPA of 3.20. They must also have satisfied the university's English Language Proficiency requirement.
- AWARD: The scholarship is \$15,000 CAD, renewable annually in the second, third and fourth year at the University of Calgary, provided recipients achieve a GPA of 2.60 or more over a minimum of 24.00 units in the previous fall and winter terms. The total amount over 4 years of undergraduate program is \$60,000 CAD.
- **DEADLINE:** The application deadline for Fall 2021 admission is 15 December 2020 (early admission) and 1 March 2021 (standard admission). The application deadline for the International Entrance Scholarship is 1 December 2020.

UNIVERSITY OF CALGARY GRADUATE AWARDS

This scholarship, launched by the government of Canada, is designed to help well qualified doctoral students pursue their studies in renowned Canadian institutions.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** For full eligibility requirements, click here.

FINCAD WOMEN IN FINANCE SCHOLARSHIP

FINCAD established FINCAD's Women in Finance scholarship to support oustanding women in the field of finance, especially in the field of derivates and financial risk management. It is also designed to give women the opportunity to cultivate and share their skills.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to women of any nationality who wish to study finance in a graduate-level program.
- **AWARD:** Recipients will be awarded \$10,000 USD to support their graduate-level studies.
- **DEADLINE:** June. Learn more here.

IDRC RESEARCH AWARDS 2021

This call is open to Canadians, permanent residents of Canada, and citizens of developing countries enrolled in a master's or a doctoral degree at a recognized university OR who have completed a master's or a doctoral degree at a recognized university.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** For full eligibility requirements, click here.

MOFCOM SCHOLARSHIP

MOFCOM Scholarship is set up by the Ministry of Commerce of People's Republic of China to further strengthen the communication and cooperation between China and other countries, as well as to develop talents for developing countries. Starting from 2015, MOFCOM Scholarship mainly sponsors the young and the middle-aged talents from recipient countries to pursue their postgraduate degree education in China and entrusts China Scholarship Council to administer the Scholarship.



The Eiffel Excellence Scholarship Program was established by the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Development to enable French higher education establishments to attract top foreign students to enrol in their master's and PhD courses. 





RUSSIAN GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

In the countries where Rossotrudnichestvo is not represented, the competitive selection is organized by Russian diplomatic missions (embassies or consulates).

- ELIGIBILITY: These scholarships are open to certain groups of foreigners, Russians living abroad, and immigrants. These students can apply for state scholarships on the same terms as Russian citizens once they pass entrance exams or Uniform State Examination (EGE).



SWISS GOVERNMENT EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FOREIGN SCHOLARS AND ARTISTS

The Swiss confederation awards governemnet excellence scholarships to international students to promote international exchange and research. Two scholarships are offered, research and art scholarships, for students seeking postgraduate degrees. Receipients are selected by the awarding body, the Federal commission for scholarships for foreign students.

- ELIGIBILITY: Research scholarships are open to post-graduate researchers in any discipline (who hold a master's degree as a minimum) who are planning to come to Switzerland to pursue research or further studies at doctoral or post-doctoral level. Art scholarships are open to art students wishing to pursue an initial master's degree in Switzerland. For full eligibility requirements, click here.
- **AWARD:** The award varies depending on the scholarship.
- **DEADLINE:** The deadline varies depending on the scholarship. Learn more here.

EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP & OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM

ETH Zurich offers an excellence scholarship & opportunity program to excellent master's students, offering cost waivers as well as specific supervision.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to excellent students both from the ETH and from other universities (national and international) wishing to pursue their master's degree at ETH Zurich. COMMONWEALTH SCHOLARSHIPS FOR DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

The Commonwealth Scholarship Commission in the UK (CSC) awards over 800 scholarships and fellowships for postgraduate study and professional development to Commonwealth citizens each year. The CSC aims to contribute to the UK's international development aims and wider overseas interests, support excellence in UK higher education, and sustain the principles of the Commonwealth. - **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to citizens of eligible countries in Sub-Saharan Africa, Europe and Eurasia, Middle East and North Africa, East Asia and Pacific, South and Central Asia, and the Western Hemisphere.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded tuition fees, monthly stipend, travel allowance, and research support grant when aplicable.

CHEVENING SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

FULBRIGHT PROGRAM

The Fulbright Program provides orientation and enrichment opportunities to enhance the Fulbright Program experience in the United States. The U.S. Department of State's Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs (ECA) sponsors the Fulbright Program under policy guidelines established by the J. William Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board (FSB) and in cooperation with bi-national Fulbright Commissions and the Public Affairs Sections of U.S. Embassies abroad.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to international students from any country who are not U.S. citizens, U.S. permanent residents, or dual citizens of the U.S. and another country. Program eligibility and selection procedures vary widely by country.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded stipend, monthly maintenance, travel and tuition assistance, grant stipends and benefits vary from country to country. Grants awarded to countries with Fulbright Commissions often differ from those to countries without Fulbright Commissions.
- **DEADLINE:** Varies based on nationalities. Learn more here.

AMERICAN UNIVERSITY EMERGING GLOBAL LEADER SCHOLARSHIP

The AU Emerging Global Leader Scholarship promotes educational access and opportunity while enhancing international diversity. - AWARD: Recipients will be awarded a scholarship to cover all billable AU expenses (full tuition, room and board) for a total of four years.

MASTERCARD FOUNDATION SCHOLARS PROGRAM FOR AFRICANS

The vision of The MasterCard Foundation Scholars Program is to educate and develop academically qualified yet economically disadvantaged young people in Africa who will contribute to the transformation of the continent.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to citizens of Sub-Saharan Africa.
- AWARD: Financial support for fees, uniforms, books and supplies, transportation, accommodation, and stipends.

WESLEYAN FREEMAN ASIAN SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Wesleyan Freeman Asian Scholarship Program provides expenses for a four-year course of study toward a bachelor's degree for up to eleven exceptionally able Asian students.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to citizens of the People's Republic of China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Malaysia, the Philippines, Singapore, South Korea, Taiwan, Thailand, and Vietnam.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded a scholarship to cover the cost of tuition and student fees (called "full tuition scholarship") regardless of his or her family's financial situation.

MICROSOFT DISABILITY SCHOLARSHIP

The disAbility Scholarship at Microsoft delivers on the mission of Microsoft's cross disability employee resource group to empower and enable people with disabilities. This scholarship enables high school students with disabilities to go to college and target a career in the technology industry. Microsoft additionally hopes that this scholarship allows more people living with disabilities to enroll in higher education, and decrease unemployment levels for this demographic

This scholarship will be awarded to promising high school seniors who plan to attend a vocational or academic college and have a financial need. THE HUBERT H. HUMPHREY FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

The Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program is for experienced professionals interested in strengthening their leadership skills through a mutual exchange of knowledge and understanding about issues of common concern in the U.S. and Fellows' home countries.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to citizens of eligible countries in Sub-Saharan Africa, Europe and Eurasia, Middle East and North Africa, East Asia and Pacific, South and Central Asia, and Western Hemisphere.
- AWARD: Recipients will be awarded payment of tuition and fees, a maintenance (living) allowance, medical insurance, book allowance, and air travel.
- **DEADLINE:** The deadlines for applicants vary by country.

LOTUS SCHOLARSHIP

The Lotus Scholarship is awarded to students who achieve high academic standards and demonstrate a financial need in order to attend University of the West (UWest). The Scholarship was established in 2012 and has so far been awarded to more than 150 students.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** This scholarship is open to new students seeking either bachelor's degrees or master's degrees at UWest. Doctoral degree students, ELI students, or students seeking certificates only are not eligible for this scholarship.

NYU WAGNER MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

THE NEXTGEN SCHOLARSHIP

The NextGen Scholarship Fund was created for international students and non-citizens who come to the United States with hopes of obtaining higher education to create a better life for themselves and their families. It is a local (Washington DC, Maryland and Virginia) scholarship program that provides one annual award to a qualified and outstanding high school senior or a current college student at a two-year or four-year college.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** To qualify for this scholarship, applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and be an international student or non-citizen enrolled in a US school. Applicants umst currently reside in Washington DC, Maryland or Virginia OR must be accepted into a college or university that is in the Washington DC, Maryland, or Virginia tri-state area
- **AWARD:** \$1,000 USD. **DEADLINE:** March.

MIT - ZARAGOZA WOMEN IN LOGISTICS AND SCM SCHOLARSHIP

Through the MIT-Zaragoza Women in Logistics and SCM Scholarship, ZLC hopes to motivate outstanding female candidates to become active leaders in the Logistics field. Candidates will be expected to show extraordinary potential for leadership and professional success, bringing new vision and commitment to the area of Logistics and Supply Chain Management.

- **ELIGIBILITY:** Scholarships are awarded only to students who have been admitted to the MIT-Zaragoza Master of Engineering in Logistics and Supply Chain Management (ZLOG) program through ZLC's regular admissions procedure.
- AWARD: 50% reduction in tuition.

ROTARY PEACE FELLOWSHIPS

Each year, Rotary awards up to 130 fully funded fellowships for dedicated leaders from around the world to study at one of our peace centers. Through academic training, practice, and global networking opportunities, the Rotary Peace Centers program develops the capacity of peace and development professionals or practitioners to become experienced and effective catalysts for peace.

- ELIGIBILITY: The ideal candidate is academically strong, has a bachelor's degree in a related field, and has work experience in peace and development. Candidates need to demonstrate a commitment to peace and conflict resolution.
- AWARD: The fellowships cover tuition and fees, room and board, round-trip transportation, and all internship and field-study expenses.
- **DEADLINE:** The applications will open in Feburary 2021.

EAST – WEST CENTER SCHOLARSHIPS AND FELLOWSHIPS
