Genderology	
Course/semester	Bachelor degree, 2/4
Main objective	Formation of ability and readiness to consider gender features of clients in professional activity, relying on knowledge of gender identity and behavior.
Contents	Genderology: approaches, basic concepts, methodology. Women's issue and its evolution. Problems of women's movement in the past and the present. The comparative-historical analysis of position of the man and woman in Russia and abroad.
Preliminary requirements	For successful assimilation of discipline the student needs to know fundamentals of sociology, the characteristic of modern cultures, basics of the theory of cultures, fundamentals of religious studies.
Structure of the course	Lectures – 36 hours, practice – 18 hours, independent work – the 14th hour. Total 108 hours (58 hours contact)
Estimation, control – examination	Mark and rating system: - 0–24 it is unsatisfactory without possibility of repeating an examination; - 25–49 it is unsatisfactory with possibility of repeating an examination; - 50–72 it is satisfactory; - 73–86 it is good; - 87–100 it is excellent. 60% – current work, 40% – examination
Features of the organization of educational process and training materials	Within the course the following educational technologies are used: RKMChP, training in small groups on the analysis of problem situations and development of versions of their decisions, selection of individual tasks of different levels of complexity, the analysis of video of materials, etc.
