Course/semester	Bachelor degree, 3/5
Main objective	Formation of knowledge of professional diagnostics and career guidance, skills of use of methods of professional diagnostics, including, with different groups of clients of social work.
Contents	History of emergence and conceptual basics of the theory of professional orientation. Organization of system of career guidance. Professional diagnostics techniques. Reflection in professional activity. Professional self-determination. Professional identity.
Preliminary requirements	For successful mastering the course students need to know basics of such courses as: "The general psychology", "Prevention of a professional stress", "Introduction to the direction".
Structure of the course	Lectures – 18 hours, practice – 36 hours, examination, independent work – the 16th hour. Total 72 hours (56 hours contact)
Estimation, control – test	Mark and rating system: - 0–24 it is unsatisfactory without possibility of repeating an examination; - 25–49 it is unsatisfactory with possibility of repeating an examination; - 50–72 it is satisfactory; - 73–86 it is good; - 87–100 it is excellent. 80% – current work, 20% – pass
